### Other Requirements:

- Artwork must be original; must not violate U.S. copyright law and becomes the property of CDSN and will not be returned. Any art medium is acceptable.
- Each poster must be clearly labeled with the following information: **Student Name, Grade, Teacher's Name, School.**
- Poster must use the theme **"How you can prevent stormwater pollution,"** and include a brief message and/or picture that supports this theme. Image should be large enough to be easily seen and understood. Posters will be judged on originality, artwork, and message delivery.
- Poster size must be between **8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28"**.
- By submitting artwork, the artist grants CDSN the permission to reproduce and display his/her artwork for use in the District's Stormwater Quality Program.

### Prizes:

The winner and their entire class will receive a field trip to the LV Wash. Lunch will be provided. The winning student will also be recognized for their accomplishment on "The Flood Channel" show airing on KCLV. Second Place winner will receive a classroom presentation from the educators at Shark Reef Aquarium. Third and honorable mentions, along with all winners will receive goody bags and have their poster displayed on the District's website.
